AMP AND OMEA ELECTION PROCEDURES

This year, each of the 13 AMP service groups will elect a representative to the AMP Board of Trustees for a three-year term. AMP service groups include Central (Ohio); DEMEC; Kentucky; Michigan; North Central (Ohio); Northeast (Ohio); Northern (Ohio); Northwest (Ohio); Other (includes Ind., Md. and W. Va.); Pennsylvania; Southwest (Ohio); Virginia; and Western (Ohio). Due to the hybrid setting for the AMP Annual Conference, service groups are encouraged to hold elections prior to the Annual Conference. AMP staff are available to coordinate and facilitate pre-conference votes, by contacting Errin Harris at eharris@amppartners.org. Any service group elections held during the Annual Conference will be held exclusively via an online voting platform. Paper ballots will not be available for in-person attendees, so all voters should bring a computer or mobile device. Additional information regarding the voting process will be distributed to all member primary contacts whose service group has not conducted an election prior to the Annual Conference.

Due to the hybrid setting for the Annual Conference, Board elections for OMEA will be held exclusively via an online voting platform. Paper ballots will not be available for in-person attendees, so all voters should bring a computer or mobile device to meetings where they intend to vote. Additional information regarding the voting process will be distributed to each member's primary contact.

The AMP and OMEA primary contacts are likely two different people from your community. Please be sure to verify that correct person is prepared to vote for AMP or OMEA, respectively, as we will not be able to change the voting representative during the meetings.
